Over \$200,000 worth of glue said to be fake seized in Mandai

PRIVATE investigators removed over \$200,000 worth of Alteco super glue, packed under the brand name Allco, from a manufacturing centre in Mandai Estate on Wednesday.

An Alteco spokesman said the action came after checks that began about two years ago, when allegedly counterfeit tubes of Alteco glue were first found to be sold here for \$2 each.

Mr Jackson Tan, Alteco's sales manager, said that its

The manufacturing, storage and export centre was said to be in Mandai Estate.

Alteco's private investigators conducted a week-long check and surveillance before moving in to remove the alleged fakes.

But Mr C.T. Tan, 39, the managing director of the company that handled the Allco tubes, said that it bought the raw material for the glue from Alteco.

"We had a deal with them to supply us with three or
